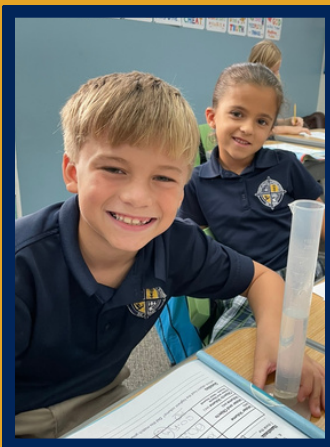

Planted in Purpose: Two New Programs

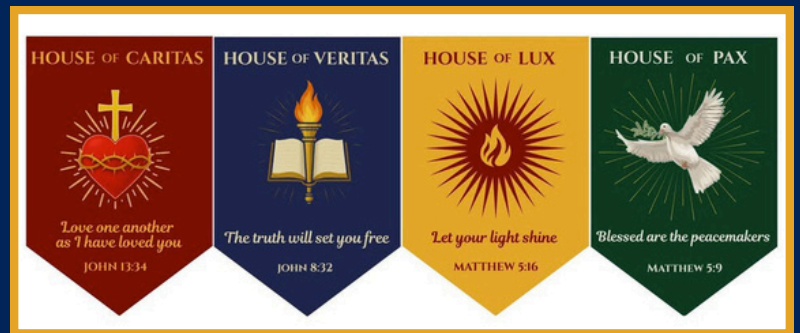
Guardian Angel Program

These special pairs sit together at daily Mass, share fun activities, and form meaningful relationships that brighten our hallways with smiles, hugs, and joy. The program has quickly become a heartwarming, faith-filled tradition that helps our children grow as leaders and disciples.



Middle School House System

Another exciting initiative that we introduced this school year is our Middle School House System, placing all 6th, 7th, and 8th graders into four houses: Veritas (Truth), Caritas (Love), Lux (Light), and Pax (Peace). Students earn points for academics, behavior, service, virtue, and friendly competitions, and each quarter the winning house enjoys a special reward. The House System is already proving to be very successful, strengthening community, building leadership, deepening faith, and fostering positive bonds through teamwork and encouragement.

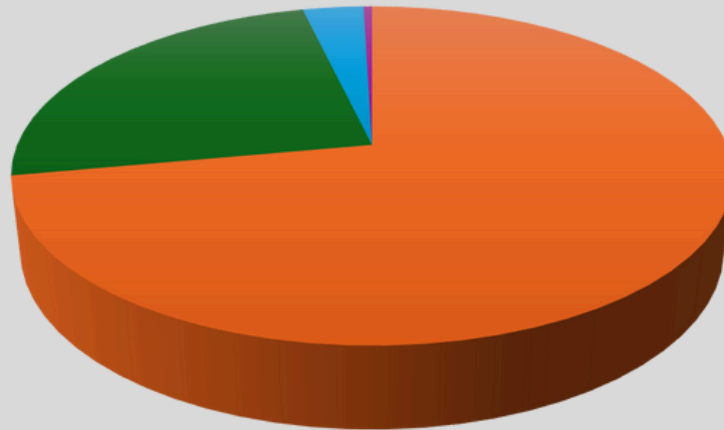

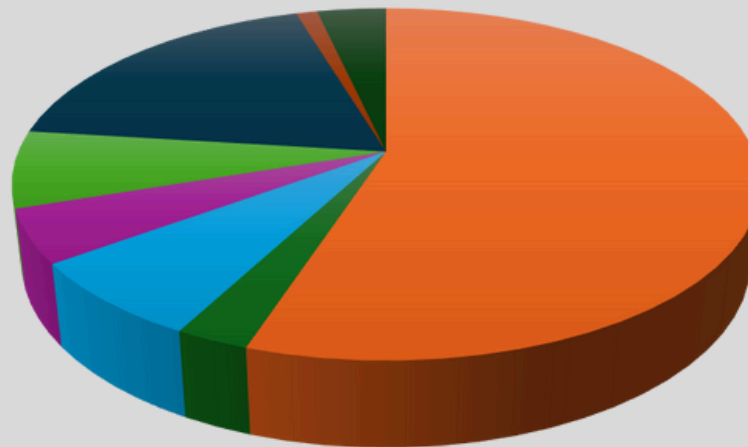
