Admissions Requirements

Kindergarten Requirements:

- Must be five (5) years old by September 1 of the year entering school
- Student interview with Kindergarten teacher
- Copy of original Birth Certificate
- Copy of original Social Security Card
- Copy of original Baptismal Certificate
- Record of a Physical after the child turns 5 years old, but before the first day of school
- Immunization Record (we do not accept exemptions) *
- Report Card or Letter of Recommendation from former program (if applicable)
- Academic Information Form
- Custody papers, legal documents (if applicable)

Interview with parent and student is required.

Immunization requirements – 5 DTP, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, Hepatitis B Series (3 shots), Varicella (2) *

First Grade through Eighth Grade Requirements:

- Copy of original Birth Certificate
- Copy of original Social Security Card
- Copy of original Baptismal Certificate
- Record of a Physical within the last 12 months prior to the first day of school **
- Immunization Record, 7th grade booster requirement, (we do not accept exemptions) *
- Most recent partial Report Card of current year – 1st, 2nd, or 3rd quarter (if applicable)
- Final Report Card of prior year
- Most recent Standardized Test Scores (if applicable)
- Academic Information Form
- Family Acknowledgement Form
- Custody papers, legal documents (if applicable)
- First grade students must be six (6) years old by September 1 of year entering school and must have successfully completed kindergarten

Interview with parents and student will be required for admission

To determine your child's grade level readiness, an academic placement test is required

7th Grade Immunization Requirement – Tdap Booster *

* All students entering St. Helen Catholic School must meet the stated immunization requirements. We do not accept exemptions. This is the policy of the Diocese of Palm Beach.

- * Every student planning to play a sport will need a “sports physical”. To prevent the need and expense of a second appointment, this can be completed during the child's annual physical.

All newly accepted students are placed on a 90 day probationary period beginning their first day of school.

Student file must be complete before it is reviewed for acceptance.
