For Students entering 3rd Grade

Required Summer Reading:

- Required novel: *Third Grade Angels* by Jerry Spinelli. Students are encouraged to read (independently or with a parent) a total of **8** books (including the one above) throughout the summer. This can be a combination of chapter books and/or short story books. Reading titles should be recorded on the “Reading Log”. One is enclosed. The reading logs will be turned in on the first day of school.

Required Summer Math:

Daily Practice of addition and subtraction facts—Pick your favorite way to practice.

Summer Bridge Activities Workbook: Students must complete all pages of the workbook (excluding the bonus activities) prior to the first day of school on August 12th. They are welcome to do any of the bonus activities for additional learning. Neatness and accuracy count. Please check your child’s work. ☺ Your child may encounter certain Math skills that were not introduced in our 2nd grade Math text. Some of these skills are a ***preview to 3rd grade***. If needed, your child may place a question mark next to these problems instead of completing them. An automatic \$10 charge for the workbook will be applied to your FACTS account. The book should be brought to school on the first day back from Summer break. Once your child has received credit for doing the work, the book will be returned to him/her.
