## For Students entering 7th Grade

We are excited to welcome your child to St. Helen Catholic School for the 2026-2027 school year. All incoming 7<sup>th</sup> Grade students are required to complete the following assignments. This will help your child retain their 6<sup>th</sup> Grade skills and ensure they are prepared for a successful start to 7<sup>th</sup> Grade.

**Summer Bridge Activities Workbook:** Students must complete at least **40 pages** (your choice of pages) of this workbook prior to the first day of school on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Neatness and accuracy count. Please check your child's work. Additional completed pages are a bonus. The book should be brought to school on the first day back from summer break. ### AND

#### **Required Summer Reading:**

Students will independently read the following required books.

- (1) *“Mother Cabrini – Missionary to the World”* by Frances Parkinson Keyes. This book can be purchased from Amazon with this link. [Mother Cabrini Book](#). Students should be prepared to participate in classroom activities related to the book during the first week of school.
- (2) Students select a **Fiction AR Book** on their Accelerated Reader (AR) reading level range (*Zone of Proximal Development* found on the STAR report sent home). The student must complete the book activity listed below, which is due the first day of school. In addition, the student will take an AR test on the book when returning to school. #### **Book Activity: Literary Analysis Board**

Create a presentation board that includes:

- Plot overview
  - Conflict analysis
  - Theme analysis
  - Character relationships
  - Author's purpose
  - Important quotes with explanations
  - Personal critique/review of the book
- \*Students should support ideas with evidence from the text and demonstrate thoughtful analysis.
